NOW THEREFORE, it is

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the above School District agrees to enter into a contract with the OCM BOCES for the provision of said services to the District not to exceed in total over the life of this agreement the estimated annual payment for equipment and Regional Information Center support of \$135,288.00.00 plus overage charges incurred by the OCM BOCES on behalf of the school district during the term of this contract. This amount may be amended with the approval of both parties. Payments will be made as part of a regular annual BOCES contract for services. Further, this contract will be finalized by the Superintendent of the school district and is subject to the approval of the Commissioner of Education for both this multi-year service agreement and the OCM BOCES Document Services Agreement contact that will be entered into on behalf of the school district at its request. This contract will be for a maximum period of 60 months commencing on or about March 31, 2019.
