12.1 <u>RESOLUTION TO CREATE COMMITTEE FOR POLICY #3160 NAMING OF</u> DISTRICT'S SCHOOLS, ROOMS, AND SITES

The Board of Education will open a period of nominations for the renaming of Auburn High School on April 14, 2021 at 8:00 am to be closed on May 5, 2021 at 4:00 pm. All nominations must be submitted in writing, via email, post, or digital submission to the District office prior to the close of business May 5th, 2021. Requests for nominations will be visible via all AECSD Social Media, the AECSD Website landing page, and the AECSD Newspaper of Record (the Auburn Citizen).

Upon the closure of the nomination period, the Board of Education will select a panel of 25 School and Community representatives. The Board of Education will seek nominations for the panel from Community Groups, AECSD Parent Teacher Organizations, the Auburn Educational Foundation (AEF), the Auburn Teachers Association (ATA), the Auburn Administrators Association (AAA), the Auburn Secretaries and Para Professional Association (ASPPA), the AECSD Civil Service Employees Association local (CSEA), all Auburn High School Student Organizations, the AHS Sports Boosters, the AHS Music Boosters, AHS Alumni Organizations, the District Parent Council, and the community at large. The Board of Education will request that the name, email address, phone number, and group affiliation of 2 volunteers and 1 alternate to sit upon the panel, be sent to the AECSD district office in writing via either email or post, prior to the close of business on May 5th. Groups will be notified of the request for panelists via post, the AECSD Website, Morning Announcements, and AECSD Social Media. Panel nominees should have a past, or current direct connection to Auburn High School. A Committee of the BOE will select panelists for consideration of the BOE prior to the May 11th BOE Regular Meeting. The slate of panelists will be presented for BOE approval at the May 11th BOE Regular Meeting. No sitting BOE member, or immediate member of their household, is permitted to be seated

on, or attend the meeting of, the panel. No members of the same household will be permitted to sit upon the panel together. Following selection, panelists will be notified of the BOE decision via email, or telephone call, and their availability confirmed. If unavailable, an alternate from the same organization will fill the vacant seat. In the event the seat is vacated by an at large community member, or no appropriate alternate is available, the seat will remain unfilled.

The panel will be moderated by Superintendent Pirozzolo, or his designee. Superintendent Pirozzolo will serve as a non-voting member of the panel. Superintendent Pirozzolo, or his designee, will keep the official minutes of the meeting. The panel will meet to discuss the slate of nominees that has been presented to the District and will make their recommendation based solely upon the list of nominees provided. The panel may choose their own method to finalize their recommendation. The panel will meet as many times as they deem necessary in order to come to a consensus on a recommendation. A recommendation of this committee must be reached prior to June 3rd, 2021. The BOE will consider the recommendation of the panel and vote upon it at the June 8th, 2021 BOE Regular Meeting for final approval, or denial.
