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# 8.2 <u>ONONDAGA-CORTLAND-MADISON BOCES - FIBER FOR HIGH SPEED</u> NETWORK

RESOLVED: THAT THE BOARD OF EDUCATION ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS HEREBY APPROVES THE FOLLOWING:

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Auburn Enlarged City School District (hereinafter referred to as the "District") desires to enter into a thirty-six month service agreement with the Onondaga-Cortland-Madison Board of Cooperative Educational Services (hereinafter referred to as OCM BOCES) in order for the OCM BOCES to furnish certain services to the District pursuant to New York State Education Law §1950(4)(jj), those services being lit fiber for high speed communications services in Co-Ser 601.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Auburn Enlarged City School District agrees to enter into a contract with the OCM BOCES for the provision of said services to the District and not to exceed in total over the life of this agreement the annual amount of \$52,138.00 and associated CNYRIC charges with such amount to include annual OCM BOCES support costs and applicable taxes and surcharges, and with such support costs and applicable taxes and surcharges included at the current rate and subject to change as established in the OCM BOCES budget or mandated by any federal, state or local authority.

This amount may be amended with the approval of both parties. The District will be liable to OCM BOCES for early cancellation or withdrawal from this agreement to the same extent that OCM BOCES is liable to any vendor(s) of these services, including liability for applicable penalties or liquidated damages, and the District will also be liable for costs and expenses, including reasonable attorneys' fees and disbursements, incurred by OCM BOCES as consequence of any such early cancellation or withdrawal. Payment will be made as part of a regular annual OCM BOCES contract for services. Further, this agreement is subject to the approval of the Board of Education of OCM BOCES. This contract will be for a maximum period of four years commencing on or about July 1, 2021, and continue through June 30, 2024.

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Auburn Enlarged City School District (the "Board of Education") has determined that it is in the best interest of the Auburn Enlarged City School District ("School District") to retain a qualified firm to provide special air monitoring and related professional services in connection with asbestos abatement work to be done in conjunction with its 2019-2023 Capital Improvement Project, Phase 1B (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the School District previously issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP") for special air monitoring and related professional services in connection with asbestos abatement work ("Services") in connection with the Project; and

WHEREAS, the School District has received proposals in response to the RFP, diligently analyzed the proposals and conducted interviews of selected candidates as part of the selection process; and

WHEREAS, the School District, as a result of the RFP process and the recommendation of the Project Construction Manager, C&S Companies, dated April 27, 2021, has selected Atlantic Testing Laboratories, Limited ("Atlantic") to provide the Services;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

- 1. The Board of Education approves the retention of Atlantic to provide special air monitoring and related professional services in connection with asbestos abatement work and proceed with the Project in accordance with the terms and conditions of a contract to be negotiated.
- 2. The Board of Education hereby authorizes the President of the Board, the Superintendent of Schools, or their designee to negotiate and enter into a contract with Atlantic on behalf of the Board of Education based on the proposal submitted in response to the RFP and take all steps necessary or convenient to proceed under the contract in connection with the Project.
- 3. Upon approval by the Board of Education, this resolution shall take effect immediately.
