- e) Reduce Tax Parcel No. 115.81-1-4.004 to \$150,000 for the 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 assessments;
- f) Reduce Tax Parcel No. 115.81-1-4.005 to \$200,000 for the 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 assessments;
- g) Reduce Tax Parcel No. 115.81-1-4.006 to \$100,000 for the 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 assessments; and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn and County of Cayuga support the settlement proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education is willing to settle the proceedings pursuant to the terms outlined above.
