- a. No reduction in the 2016 and 2017 assessments; and
- b. Reduce the 2018, 2019, 2020 assessments to \$1,200,000; and

WHEREAS, KeyBank has proposed a settlement of the proceedings for the 268 Grant Avenue property upon the following terms:

- a. No reduction in the 2016 and 2017 assessments;
- b. Reduce the 2018, 2019, 2020 assessments to \$1,500,000; and
- c. Reduce the 2021 assessment to \$950,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn and Cayuga County support the settlement proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education is willing to settle the proceedings pursuant to the terms outlined above.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:
