## Dear Auburn Families,

Welcome to the 2020-2021 school year! This year is sure to be unconventional and much different than we are all used to, but I am confident that we will prevail. I know many students and parents are apprehensive about how this school year will flow. Guidelines from the state are constantly changing, so our plan will continue to be fluid. We just have to be flexible and willing to adapt to these changes as they come.

As you know, the district is moving forward with a hybrid learning model, but we are bringing students back into our buildings in phases. Please refer to the Phase-In Approach diagram inside the newsletter. I think it is crucial to get all of our students back to school, but it is also crucial to make sure we do it safely for our students and for our staff. Phasing in to our hybrid learning model is the most logical and responsible way to do this. **We have one chance to reopen our schools, and we have to get it right.** If we don't, we will have to close down just as soon as we open.

Parents who have requested a full remote learning model of instruction for children in Grs. 7 through 12 will be able to request a transfer to the hybrid learning model at any time once they feel comfortable with the health and safety guidelines the district has in place or if they feel the full remote learning model is not working for them. Transfers at the secondary level will be accommodated as long as space allows with the current health and safety guidelines in place.

Parents who have requested a full remote learning model of instruction for children in Grs. K through 6 have committed to that plan until January 2021 due to the curriculum's scope and sequence programs. At that time, parents may request a transfer to the hybrid learning model.

There will be much for all of us to learn this year with new health and safety protocols. We have never had to screen students and staff before entering our buildings. We have never been challenged with being accountable for testing and tracing. Bringing students back in phases will allow us to perfect these protocols and hopefully safeguard against the virus entering our schools.

In addition to getting used to the new health and safety protocols, we also have to master remote learning. Even though we will have students learning in-person this year, three of the five days are still remote learning days. Not to mention, we have to be prepared to move into a full remote learning model at any point during the school year. Much of the

professional development that took place over the summer had to do with remote learning. Many of our staff members took advantage of these opportunities – they are truly dedicated to our district and our students.

The district has been working hard to help families whose students are in the Hybrid Learning Model find options to assist with remote learning. I would like to announce two Remote Learning Assistance Programs we were able to coordinate with the YMCA of Auburn and Champions for Life, Inc. The Y will be offering a program called Learn & Grow, and Champions for Life will be offering a program called Learning Labs. Both programs are designed to assist families who need help for their children in Grades K through 6 on remote learning days and will provide opportunities to complete their academic coursework as well as provide recreational opportunities. More information about these programs is included inside the newsletter.

I would also like to announce the revamping of our District Parent Council. Based on feedback from community members at the August 25 board meeting, I came up with the idea to revamp this group into a reopening and planning committee. The group will be renamed the District Parent Reopening Committee (DPRC), and the focus of the group will be around how we can get our students back into our buildings for school five days a week.

The District Parent Reopening Committee will normally meet on the first Monday of every month, but the **first meeting will be Monday, September 14 at 6:30 p.m. in the Auburn High School auditorium.** We encourage anyone who would like to be a part of the reopening discussions to attend. You do not need to sign up or contact anyone about joining. Just show up! I will update members of the committee on reopening plans and any changing guidelines from the state, as well as discuss current procedures and protocols. The ultimate goal is to find a way to bring our students physically back into school every day.

On behalf of the Board of Education and administration, thank you for your continued support of the Auburn Enlarged City School District. We look forward to seeing all of our students! Sincerely,

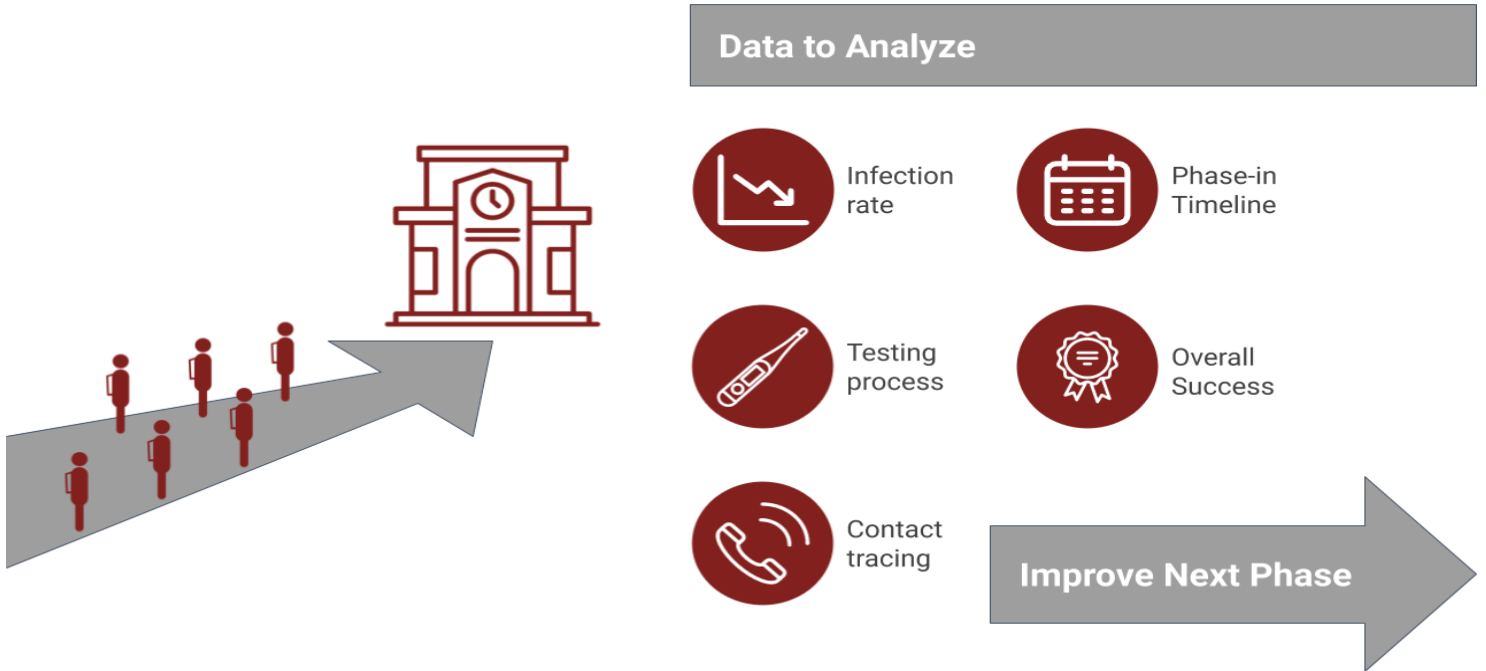

## Phase-in Approach for Hybrid Learning at Auburn ECSD

The Auburn Enlarged City School District is planning a phase-in approach for hybrid learning. Each phase brings more grade levels into school. At each phase the district will analyze federal, state and local mandates, the infection rate, testing and contact tracing process, timeline, and overall success of bringing in new students. This analysis will be used to determine when to begin the next phase and improve its implementation.

### Ongoing Analysis to Improve the Next Phase

The data analysis from the current phase will help improve the next phase and determine when it should begin.



### TENTATIVE Schedule of Phases

These dates are tentative and subject to change based on the success of the previous phase.

### Stay home except to get medical care

**Stay home.** Most people with COVID-19 have mild illness and can recover at home without medical care. Do not leave your home, except to get medical care. Do not visit public areas.

**Take care of yourself.** Get rest and stay hydrated. Take over-the-counter medicines, such as acetaminophen, to help you feel better.

#### Stay in touch with your doctor.

Call before you get medical care. Be sure to get care if you have trouble breathing, or have any other emergency warning signs, or if you think it is an emergency.

**Avoid public transportation, ride-sharing, or taxis.**

### Separate yourself from other people

As much as possible, stay in a specific room and away from other people and pets in your home. If possible, you should use a separate bathroom. If you need to be around other people or animals in or outside of the home, wear a cloth face covering.

### Clean all “high-touch” surfaces everyday

**High-touch surfaces include phones, remote controls, counters, tabletops, doorknobs, bathroom fixtures, toilets, keyboards, tablets, and bedside tables.**

#### Avoid sharing personal household items

Do not share dishes, cups, drinking glasses, eating utensils, towels, or bedding with other people in your home. Wash these items thoroughly after using them with soap and water or put in the dishwasher. Visit:

### Clean your hands often

Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. This is especially important after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing; going to the bathroom; and before eating or preparing food.

**Use hand sanitizer** if soap and water are not available. Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol, covering all surfaces of your hands and rubbing them together until they feel dry.

**Soap and water** are the best option, especially if hands are visibly dirty.

**Avoid touching** your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.

## Steps to Help Prevent the Spread of COVID-19

If you are sick with COVID-19 or think you might have COVID-19, follow these steps to care for yourself and to help protect other people in your home and community.

### When to Seek Emergency Medical Attention

**Look for emergency warning signs\* for COVID-19. If someone is showing any of these signs, seek emergency medical care immediately:**

- **Trouble breathing**
- **Persistent pain or pressure in the chest**
- **New confusion**
- **Inability to wake or stay awake**
- **Bluish lips or face**

\*This list is not all possible symptoms. Please call your medical provider for any other symptoms that are severe or concerning to you. Call 911 or call ahead to your local emergency facility: Notify the operator that you are seeking care for someone who has or may have COVID-19.

### What to Do If You Are Sick

If you have a fever, cough or other symptoms, you might have COVID-19. Most people have mild illness and are able to recover at home. If you think you may have been exposed to COVID-19, contact your healthcare provider. Keep track of your symptoms.

### Monitor your symptoms

**Symptoms** of COVID-19 include fever, cough, or other symptoms. Follow care instructions from your healthcare provider and local health department. Your local health authorities may give instructions on checking your symptoms and reporting information.

### Cover your coughs and sneezes

Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw away used tissues in a lined trash can.

**Immediately wash your hands** with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, clean your hands with an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol. Visit: [Handwashing Tips](#)

### If you are sick wear a cloth covering over your nose and mouth

You should wear a **Cloth Face Covering**, over your nose and mouth if you must be around other people or animals, including pets (even at home).

You don't need to wear the cloth face covering if you are alone. If you can't put on a cloth face covering (because of trouble breathing, for example), cover your coughs and sneezes in some other way. Try to stay at least 6 feet away from other people. This will help protect the people around you.

Cloth face coverings should not be placed on young children under age 2 years, anyone who has trouble breathing, or anyone who is not able to remove the covering without help.

Note: During the COVID-19 pandemic, medical grade face masks are reserved for healthcare workers and some first responders. You may need to make a cloth face covering using a scarf or bandana.

### Call ahead before visiting your doctor

Call ahead. Many medical visits for routine care are being postponed or done by phone or telemedicine.

If you have a medical appointment that cannot be postponed, call your doctor's office, and tell them you have or may have COVID-19. This will help the office protect themselves and other patients.

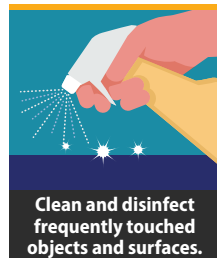
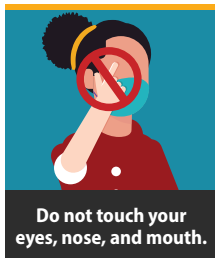
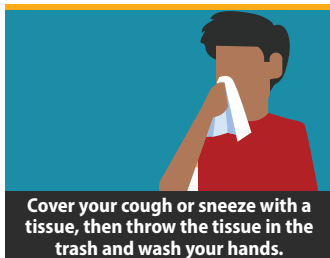

The school district is pleased to continue our partnership with Anonymous Alerts®, the anti-bullying and safety reporting app and system. Starting in the 2018-2019 school year, this safety communications tool is a way for our students to quickly communicate anonymously with school officials and engage in anonymous 2-way communications to share more information about incidents. Types of concerns that may be reported include, but are not limited to, bullying, harassment, drug-related issues, fighting, weapons, threats, and more. The goal of this reporting system is to help maintain a safe school climate while giving students ample opportunity to securely communicate with school administrators without fear of retribution by their peers. The system will be monitored during school days between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

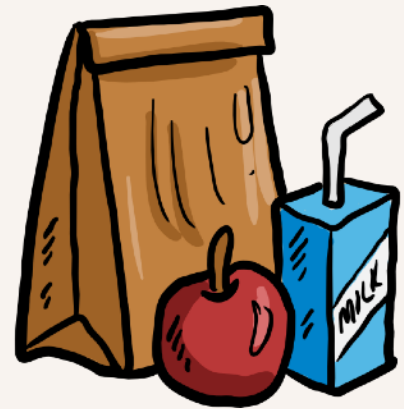

## **CASEY PARK ELEMENTARY: *NEW DROP OFF/PICK UP ZONE!***

As we approach the beginning of a new school year, Casey Park Administration, the Auburn Police Department, and the Auburn Highway Department have worked in collaboration to address some of the ongoing challenges faced during arrival and dismissal during the school year at Casey Park Elementary School. As a result, you will see improvements have been made to the signage and street markings in front of the school. In doing this, sections for drop off and pick-up only have been clearly identified. No parking zones are marked off - including the space near the bus lane, in the crosswalk and right in front of the school. Single points of entry and exit for the parking lot across from the school have been redefined.

### ***A few reminders for all families dropping off or picking up students:***

-  If you are dropping your child off and do not need to exit the vehicle yourself, please pull over in the approved sections on the street. Students will exit the car on the side of the sidewalk and will either walk to the crosswalk or walk on the sidewalk to the school entry.
-  If you need to come to the door with your child, YOU MUST park in the further half of the parking lot across from the school. Please walk to the sidewalk and utilize the crosswalk when crossing the street.
-  Handicapped spaces are clearly designated in the parking lot across from school. Please do not park here unless you have handicap permissions, which can be clearly viewed.
-  Do not cross through the bus lane. All students and family members must utilize the crosswalk.
-  Please do not stop and let children out in the middle of the street or in the middle of the crosswalk.

A huge thank you goes to Auburn Police Department and the Auburn City Highway Department for working with us to create a safe space for children and families. If you have questions, please call Casey Park Elementary at 315-255-8760.



## **Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA)**

Students who are applying to colleges, please be aware that procedures for the confidentiality of student records within the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA) have recently changed. FERPA permits school officials to disclose all education records, including disciplinary records, to another institution at which the student seeks or intends to enroll. This now also applies to post-secondary institutions (colleges), upon request.

### Free and Reduced Meal Applications for 2020-2021

**Income Eligibility** guidelines and new Free & Reduced Meal Application forms for students at the junior high and high school are available in all school buildings, at the District Office, and online at [www.aecsd.education](http://www.aecsd.education).

## THE DISTRICT WELLNESS POLICY

The **Auburn Enlarged City School District** is committed to providing students with a school environment that promotes student health and wellness and reduces childhood obesity. The District Wellness Policy can be viewed on the district website. As part of the policy, the district shall:

- **ensure** that all foods and beverages available in school promote good nutrition, balance and reasonable portion sizes;
- **promote** the sale of non-food items or activities for school fundraisers;
- **require** non-food classroom celebrations; (see article on p. 4)
- **promote** the integration of physical activity in the classroom and encourage staff, families and community to participate in and model physical activity as a valuable part of daily life;
- **integrate** nutrition education that teaches the knowledge, skills and values needed to adopt healthy eating behaviors into the curriculum;
- **promote** fruits, vegetables, whole grain products, low fat dairy products, safe and healthy food preparation methods and health-enhancing nutrition practices;
- **inform** and update the public about the content, implementation and effectiveness of this policy.

## • BACK-TO-SCHOOL CHECKLIST •

### For Parents Who Have Students with a Health Concern:

- ➔ Make your child's health concern known to the school and school nurse.
- ➔ Introduce yourself and your child to the school nurse.
- ➔ Bring current signed healthcare provider orders.
- ➔ Together with the school nurse and other appropriate school officials, and family, develop an individualized healthcare plan (or other educational plans, as needed, e.g., 504, IEP).
- ➔ Give permission for the school nurse to communicate with your family's healthcare provider.
- ➔ Provide parent/guardian contact information and update the school with any changes.
- ➔ Ask if non-nurses will be providing care (for example, verify who will administer medication) and how these authorized individuals will be supervised.
- ➔ Confirm the school's disaster/emergency plan. Make sure your child's medication and/or medical devices (epinephrine auto-injectors, asthma inhalers, insulin, etc.) will be readily available in an emergency.

### For All Parents and Students:

- ➔ Make sure immunizations are up-to-date.
- ➔ Review hygiene tips to prevent the spread of infections.
- ➔ Establish a bedtime and wake-up time to ensure adequate and consistent sleep.
- ➔ Develop a routine for homework and after school activities.
- ➔ Eat breakfast each day at home or at school.
- ➔ Help make appropriate clothing choices (for example, wear comfortable and safe shoes).
- ➔ Keep an open line of communication with your child to ensure that he/she remains safe at school. If a concern arises (such as bullying), contact the appropriate school officials immediately.
- ➔ Get involved! Sign up for the parent organization (PTA/PTO), District Wellness Committee, District Parent Council, and mark events such as back-to-school night and parent/teacher meetings on your calendar.
- ➔ Ask about the school or district's wellness policy (for example, how does the school address nutrition, activity, stress and mental health concerns).

## STUDENT HEALTH EXAMINATIONS UPDATE

All students in Kindergarten and grades 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11, as well as students wishing to participate in sports or become eligible for a working permit, and all new students to the district are mandated by New York State Education Law to have a current examination on record in the health office. The Health Staff encourages you to use your private health care provider for all required school health appraisals for better continuity of care. Should you choose to have a health appraisal done by the school physician or nurse practitioner in school, it will be scheduled at the convenience of the district.

Your child will be asked to disrobe to underclothing. While every effort is made to preserve dignity and privacy, most health offices are too small to provide the level of privacy your child may be used to in his or her private provider's office.

The physician conducts a mini-interview for history. These are age appropriate questions identified by the American Medical Association and the American Academy of Pediatrics. Next, the physical screening examination is done. The exam includes a head-to-toe screening of all major organ systems. Please do not ask the school to conduct this exam unless you seek your own child's permission and understanding of the nature of the exam. Because school examinations, by law, are only screening exams and school providers may not diagnose or prescribe in a school setting, you will be advised of any areas of concern found on examination that require further evaluation by your own provider.

One last suggestion regarding private examinations. Most physicians recommend that you time annual exams around your child's birthday. It may take six to twelve weeks to schedule an appointment, especially over the summer. Please plan accordingly if you have these exams done privately. We understand that during this transition we will all need to be flexible, especially regarding sports participation. Our goal is to facilitate your child's ability to play in a chosen sport. All we ask is that if you have already had an exam done, that you please take a moment to call your private physician to get proof of the exam into the school nurse as soon as possible.

## PESTICIDE NOTIFICATION

Dear Parents, Guardians, and School Staff:

New York State Education Law Section 409-H, effective July 1, 2001, requires all public and nonpublic elementary and secondary schools to provide written notification to all persons in parental relation, faculty, and staff regarding the potential use of pesticides periodically throughout the school year.

The Auburn Enlarged City School District is required to maintain a list of persons in parental relation, faculty, and staff who wish to receive 48-hour prior written notification of certain pesticide applications. The following pesticide applications are not subject to prior notification requirements:

- a school remains unoccupied for a continuous 72-hours following an application;
- anti-microbial products;
- nonvolatile rodenticides in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children;
- nonvolatile insecticidal baits in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children;
- silica gels and other nonvolatile ready-to-use pastes, foams, or gels in areas inaccessible to children;
- boric acid and disodium octaborate tetrahydrate;
- the application of EPA designated biopesticides;
- the application of EPA designated exempt materials under 40CFR152.25;
- the use of aerosol products with a directed spray in containers of 18 fluid ounces or less when used to protect individuals from an imminent threat from stinging and biting insects including venomous spiders, bees, wasps, and hornets.

In the event of an emergency application necessary to protect against an imminent threat to human health, a good faith effort will be made to supply written notification to those on the 48-hour prior notification list.

## FEDERAL ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT (AHERA) NOTIFICATION

The Auburn Enlarged City School District, in accordance with Section 763.93 of the Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), submitted Asbestos Management Plans to the New York State Education Department in 1989. Updated and reviewed annually, these plans contain reports of the accredited asbestos inspector and the reports of the accredited laboratory which analyzed the inspection samples that were taken.



The Management Plans also describe:

- Places in each school building where asbestos was identified
- Response actions taken to date including abatement of asbestos in elementary, junior high and high school boiler rooms, corridors, classrooms, crawl spaces, and storage areas.

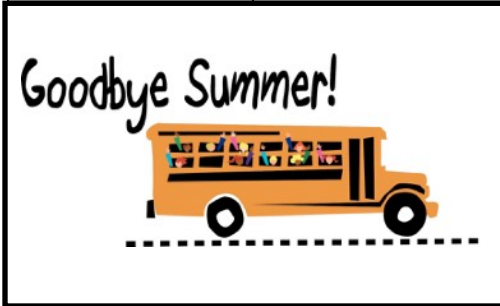

### Enhanced STAR Exemption for Senior Citizens

Senior property owners who already have a Basic STAR Exemption on their primary residence may be eligible for the Enhanced STAR Exemption when they are 65. You should apply when you are 64 so that, if you qualify, you may receive the exemption beginning the year that you turn 65. Auburn city residents should contact the Assessor's Office at City Hall on South Street (255-4125). Other Auburn (Aurelius, Throop, Owasco, Sennett, Fleming) and Cayuga County residents should contact their local assessor's office. The deadline for applications for Auburn city residents is February 1. Other Auburn and Cayuga County residents should check with their local assessor.

The Enhanced STAR program for senior citizens provides eligible seniors an exemption from school property taxes for owner-occupied, primary residences. To be eligible for this exemption, a property owner must be 65 years of age or older on December 31, 2020, with income not exceeding \$88,050.

STAR provides qualifying households with up to a \$69,800 exemption on the full value of their property. Qualifying residents owning a home with a full value of \$100,000 will recognize an estimated \$1,181 in Enhanced STAR tax savings in 2020-2021.
