Self-discipline is doing what you know you should do even when no one is looking.

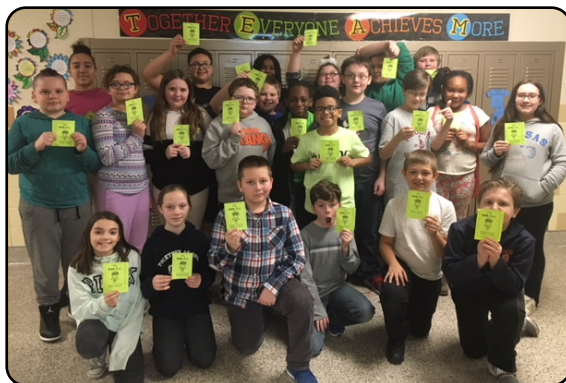
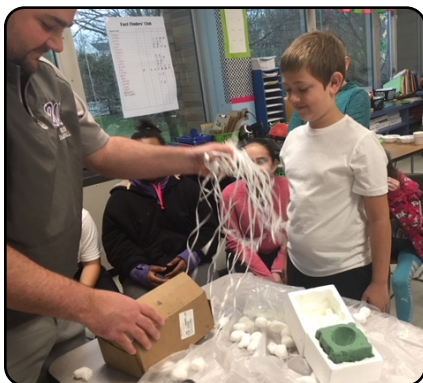
Display **self-discipline** by:
