
March Character Trait: Teamwork/Cooperation

Mrs. Querns, Mrs. Mennerich and Mrs. Gutelius's classes presented their science work to the Board of Education on February 27!









Thank you to our cup stackers for representing Casey Park so well in this year's District Cup Stacking competition!


