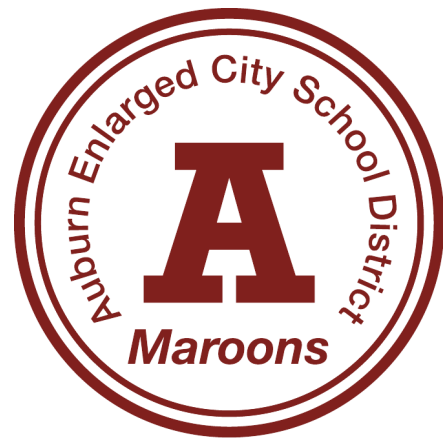

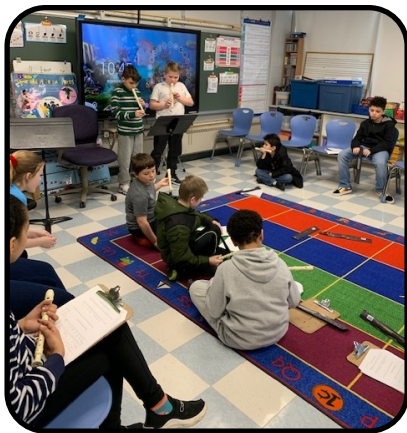
Child Safety Matters

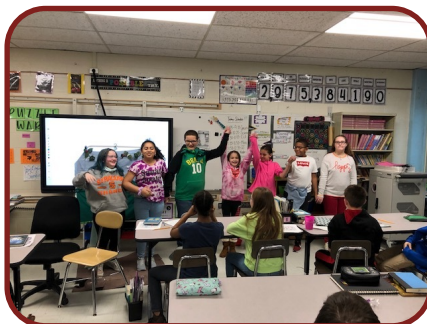
Practicing Recorders
