Greetings Casey Park Families,

Throughout November, we have continued our PBIS push and the focus on positive behaviors in the cafeteria. Each day, **every class has the opportunity to earn a PAW at the end of lunch** for displaying positive behaviors during lunch. After students earned 75 PAWS collectively to achieve their last school-wide celebration, which was additional recess time, they voted for a **school-wide movie day** once they reach the next target of **300 PAWS**. The **movie day is scheduled for Dec. 8**, and we are **just a few PAWS away!**

As part of our **Every Student Present** attendance initiative, we have been recognizing **Casey Park Attendance Champs**, students who have missed 0, 1, or 2 days of school in the previous month, at our Top Dog Assemblies. There are different **incentives for students with good attendance**; November's raffle winners get to lead the pledge at December's Board of Education meeting.

In the month of **December**, we are launching an attendance incentive program called **STRIVE FOR 95**. The goal is for the school to **reach a 95% or better attendance rate for the month**, and once we do, **students will earn a school-wide game day!** School-wide attendance percentages will be tracked on the wall in the main lobby to remind everyone of the importance of being present in school. **Please ensure your children get to school every day in December to help us meet our goal!**
