When picking up your child, please stop in to the Main Office, and the secretary will call the classroom to inform your child that it is time to leave. This will minimize disruption in the classroom and ensure that students are picked up by a parent or guardian. Students are expected to be in school from 8:45 a.m. - dismissal (see walker/bus release times). Except in the case of emergencies, students may not be dismissed early after 2:45 p.m.

## Anonymous Alerts

We are introducing a new tool called **Anonymous Alerts**, which is an online system that allows students to quickly, easily, and anonymously report strange behavior and information to school officials.

**Possible incidents to report could include:**

- Bullying / Cyberbullying
- Family difficulties
- Self-harm
- Drug and alcohol abuse
- Student depression
- Sexual harassment
- Fighting
- Weapons
- Threats
- Abnormal student behavior

The best way to address problems faced in school is by telling a teacher, principal, psychologist, or counselor. However, we do understand that sometimes a student may want to communicate something anonymously. **The most important thing to remember is: See something. Do something!**

All reports submitted through Anonymous Alerts remain completely anonymous, but students do have the option to reveal their identity. The program is monitored from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. on school days, but it is very important to understand that school officials will not be on the system every minute. Anonymous Alerts should only be used for serious matters, but **if something seems disturbing or life threatening, call 911 immediately.**
