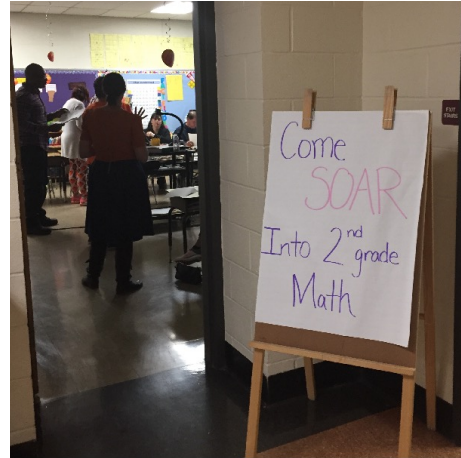




# SOAR INTO LEARNING

## Kindergarten Fire Safety Presentation

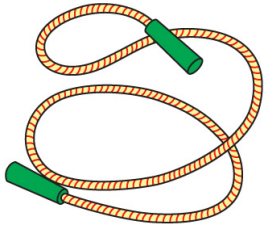
Thank you to the Auburn Fire Department for visiting the classrooms and discussing fire safety with the students.

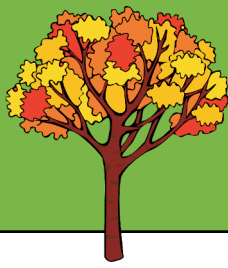
