Participation Guidelines:

Marking Period and Mid-Marking Period Reports

- If a student has a grade below 65 in Math, Social Studies, English, Science, French, Spanish, or Italian at the conclusion of the Mid-Marking Period or Marking Period, they will be expected to attend the ASIP program at least once per week for each course they are failing. Once the new MP/MMP grades come out, if passing, the student will no longer need to attend.
- Sports/Extracurricular - Students are **required** to attend in order to participate in extracurricular activities, modified sports and games. If the student is failing 2 MP/MMP in a row, they may attend practices and rehearsals, however they will not be allowed to participate in games or performances.
- School Dances - you need to attend ASIP every day you are required to attend during that MP/MMP in order to go to school dances.
