WHO: All 8th Grade Students


WHEN: Career Shadow December 12, 2025

HOW: You need to make the arrangements for this day.

WHERE: Once you have selected your career area, you need to find a location to shadow.

- * Talk to Parent/Guardian— If they work at a place you would like to visit, ask them if there is someone there you can shadow.
- * Check with relatives and neighbors that you know.
- * Ask your teachers and school staff if they have any ideas.
- * Do an online search for businesses in the area. Visit your library

Commonly asked questions:

CAN I GO WITH MY PARENT/GUARDIAN?

See if there is someone else there that you can shadow. If you have already been to your parent's job, find a different experience.

CAN I GO WITH ONE OF MY FORMER

TEACHERS? You have had a lot of experience watching what teachers do. We would like you to try a new and different experience. See your school counselor if you have questions about this.

HOW DO I GET TO THE JOB SITE? You need to work out transportation with your parent/guardian or find a place that you can walk to. If transportation is an issue, see your school counselor as soon as possible

DOES IT HAVE TO BE IN AUBURN? No, you can go anywhere you like as long as you have transportation.



WHAT IF THE PERSON WANTS ME TO COME ON A DIFFERENT DAY? We would like you to go on your assigned day, but if you have special circumstances and need to visit on another day, see your school counselor for approval. You will also need to notify your teachers and make up any missed work.

WHAT SHOULD I WEAR? Ask your job mentor. If they don't give specific guidelines then dress conservatively. Or dress in a way that matches the type of job you are shadowing.

WHAT SHOULD I BRING? Ask your job mentor. Should I bring a lunch or money for lunch? If any of your teachers give you an assignment, make sure to bring that.

WHAT IF I CAN'T FIND A PLACE? Keep a list of all the places you have tried, then make an appointment with your School Counselor. There are lots of great places students have gone and we have all that information in our offices.

FOLLOW UP – If you don't hear back follow-up 24 to 48 hours later:


