WHEREAS, THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE AUBURN ENLARGED CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT DESIRES TO ENTER INTO UP TO A FIVE YEAR SERVICE CONTRACT WITH THE ONONDAGA-CORTLAND-MADISON BOARD OF COOPERATIVE EDUCATIONAL SERVICES (HEREAFTER REFERRED TO AS OCM BOCES) IN ORDER FOR THE REGIONAL INFORMATION CENTER (RIC) TO

FURNISH CERTAIN SERVICES TO THE DISTRICT PURSUANT TO EDUCATION LAW 1950(4)(JJ), THOSE SERVICES BEING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CLASSROOM TECHNOLOGY AND LIBRARY AUTOMATION AND OTHER INSTRUCTIONAL TECHNOLOGIES IN COSER 562 AND/OR CO-SER 620.
