Renovations, improvements and modifications at the District's Senior High School, Casey Park Elementary School, Genesee Elementary School, Herman Ave. Elementary, Owasco Elementary, William H. Seward Elementary, Auburn Junior High School and the Tubman Administration Building, including, but not limited to interior and exterior building

Regular Board of Education Meeting, Tuesday, October 23, 2018 renovations, HVAC, security, parking and playgrounds, as well as roofing renovations.

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the scope of the project and has further received and considered the advice of its Architects with respect to the potential for environmental impacts resulting from the proposed action; and

WHEREAS, the Board has reviewed the Proposed Action with respect to the Type II criteria set forth in 6 NYCRR part 617.5(c), now therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education as follows:

- 1. The Proposed Action does not exceed thresholds established under 6 NYCRR Part 617, State Environmental Quality Review Act, (SEQRA).
- 2. The Board hereby determines the Proposed Action as a Type II action in accordance with the SEQRA regulations.
- 3. No further review of the Proposed Action is required under SEORA.
- 4. This resolution shall be effective immediately.

RESOLVED: THAT THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT, OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, NEW YORK, AND UPON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS AND,

Pursuant to Education Law §2512(3), the Board of Education of the Enlarged City School District of the City of Auburn, New York has

Regular Board of Education Meeting, Tuesday, October 23, 2018 determined the necessity for certain capital improvements consisting of reconstruction and equipping of its seven school buildings and one administration building, and associated facilities, including various site improvements, and other ancillary or incidental improvements, if any, as deemed necessary in connection therewith for such construction and school use, all at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$43,700,000 (Forty three million, seven hundred thousand dollars).

The necessity for the above is summarized as "Exhibit #8" attached hereto and occurred as a result of deliberations by the Board of Education and its various committees during the 2016, 2017 and 2018 school years, and is set forth in the minutes of the 9/11/2018 and 9/25/2018 Board of Education meetings. These plans were reviewed with the public at Board of Education Workshop session on 7/2/2018 and at information sessions held on 10/9/2018 and 10/11/2018.

8.9 BOND RESOLUTION DATED OCTOBER 23, 2018 OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE AUBURN ENLARGED CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT AUTHORIZING GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS TO FINANCE CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS CONSISTING OF RECONSTRUCTION OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES WITHIN THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BOND ANTICIPATION NOTES IN CONTEMPLATION THEREOF, THE LEVY OF TAXES IN ANNUAL INSTALLMENTS IN PAYMENT THEREOF, THE EXPENDITURE OF SUCH SUMS FOR SUCH PURPOSE, AND DETERMINING OTHER MATTERS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has, on October 23, duly determined that the purpose hereinafter described constitutes a type II action under the State Environmental Quality Review Act of the State of New York and the applicable regulations thereunder ("SEQRA") which will not have a significant impact on the environment and such purpose is not subject to any further environmental review under SEQRA; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THIS BOARD OF EDUCATION AS FOLLOWS:

Vote as follows:

Section 1. The Auburn Enlarged City School District shall undertake certain capital improvements to the School District's existing school buildings and facilities, as more particularly described in Section 3 hereof.

Section 2. The Auburn Enlarged City School District is hereby authorized to issue its General Obligation Serial Bonds in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$43,700,000, pursuant to

Regular Board of Education Meeting, Tuesday, October 23, 2018 the Local Finance Law of New York, in order to finance the class of objects or purposes described herein.

- Section 3. The specific object or purpose to be financed pursuant to this resolution (hereinafter referred to as "purpose") is certain capital improvements consisting of reconstruction of school buildings and facilities within the School District (each such building being a class "A" (fireproof and certain fire resistant) building as defined in Subdivision 11 of Paragraph a of Section 11.00 of said Local Finance Law), various site improvements, and the acquisition of certain original furnishings, equipment, and apparatus and other incidental improvements required in connection therewith for such construction and school use.
- Section 4. It is hereby determined and declared that (a) the aggregate maximum cost of said purpose, as estimated by the Board of Education, is \$43,700,000, and such amount is hereby appropriated therefor; and (b) the Auburn Enlarged City School District plans to finance the cost of said purpose entirely from funds raised by the issuance of said Bonds and the Bond Anticipation Notes hereinafter referred to; and (c) no money has heretofore been authorized to be applied to the payment of the cost of said purpose.
- Section 5. It is hereby determined that the purpose is one of the class of objects or purposes described in Subdivision 97 of Paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law, and that the period of probable usefulness of said purpose is thirty (30) years.
- Section 6. The Auburn Enlarged City School District is hereby authorized to issue its Bond Anticipation Notes in the aggregate principal amount of not to exceed \$43,700,000, and is hereby authorized to issue renewals thereof, pursuant to the Local Finance Law of New York in order to finance the purpose in anticipation of the issuance of the above described Bonds.
- Section 7. It is hereby determined and declared that (a) there are presently no outstanding Bond Anticipation Notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said Bonds, (b) the Bond Anticipation Notes authorized hereby shall mature within one year of the date of issuance thereof or such longer term as may be desired in accordance with the provisions of the Local Finance Law, (c) the Bond Anticipation Notes authorized hereby are not issued in anticipation for Bonds for an assessable improvement, and (d) current funds will be provided prior to the issuance of the Bonds or Bond Anticipation Notes herein authorized, to the extent, if any, required by Section 107.00 of the Local Finance Law.
- Section 8. It is hereby determined and declared that the Auburn Enlarged City School District reasonably expects to reimburse the general fund, or such other fund as may be utilized, not to exceed the maximum

Regular Board of Education Meeting, Tuesday, October 23, 2018 amount authorized herein, from the proceeds of the obligations authorized hereby for expenditures, if any, from such fund that may be made for the purpose prior to the date of issuance of such obligations. This is a declaration of official intent under Treasury Regulation §1.150-2.

Section 9. The faith and credit of the Auburn Enlarged City School District, New York, are hereby irrevocably pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on such Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations becoming due and payable in such year. There shall annually be levied on all taxable real property of said School District, a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same become due and payable.

The power to further authorize the sale and issuance of said Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes and to prescribe the terms, form and contents of said Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes, subject to the provisions of this resolution and the Local Finance Law of New York, including without limitation, the authority to determine whether to accept bids electronically to the extent allowed by Section 58.00 of the Local Finance Law, the consolidation with other issues, the determination to issue Bonds with substantially level or declining annual debt service, all contracts for, and determinations with respect to credit or liquidity enhancements, if any, and to sell, issue and deliver said Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes, subject to the provisions of this resolution and Local Finance Law, is hereby delegated to the President of the Board of Education or to the Vice President of the Board in the event of the absence or unavailability of the President. The President of the Board of Education, Vice President and the District Clerk are hereby authorized to sign by manual or facsimile signature any Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes issued pursuant to this resolution, and are hereby authorized to affix to such Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes the corporate seal of the School District and to attest the same. The President of the Board of Education is additionally authorized (but not required) to execute and deliver a financing agreement with the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York and any other agreements and documents necessary to accomplish a financing, all as may be determined in the discretion of the President of the Board of Education.

Section 11. After compliance with Section 12 hereof, this resolution, or a summary hereof, shall be published in full by the District Clerk of the School District together with a notice in substantially the form prescribed by Section 81.00 of said Local Finance Law, and such publication shall be in each official newspaper of the School District. The validity of said Bonds and Bond Anticipation Notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said Bonds may be contested only if such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said School District is not authorized to expend money, or the provisions of law which should be complied with, at the date of publication of this

Regular Board of Education Meeting, Tuesday, October 23, 2018 resolution are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity, is commenced within twenty (20) days after the date of such publication; or if said obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

<u>Section 12</u>. This resolution shall be submitted to a referendum of the qualified electors of the School District on January 8, 2018 pursuant to Section 37.00 of the Local Finance Law of the State of New York and shall take effect immediately upon approval at such referendum.

8.10 NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING OF THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF AUBURN ENLARGED CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special meeting of the qualified voters of the Enlarged City School District of the City of Auburn, New York, shall be held at the polling places as hereinafter set forth, on Tuesday, January 8, 2019, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. to vote on the following proposition:

PROPOSITION

Shall the bond resolution adopted by the Board of Education of the Auburn Enlarged City School District, dated October 23, 2018, authorizing capital improvements consisting of reconstruction of school buildings and other facilities, various site improvements, and the acquisition of certain original furnishings, equipment, and apparatus and other incidental improvements required in connection therewith for such construction and school use, at an estimated maximum aggregate cost of \$43,700,000; and providing that such cost, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be raised by the levy of a tax to be collected in annual installments with such tax to be partially offset by state aid available therefor, and in anticipation of such tax, debt obligations of the school district as may be necessary, not to exceed such estimated maximum cost, shall be issued, all be approved?

PROPOSITION #1

Shall the bond resolution, dated October 23, 2018, set forth in the legal notice of this special voter meeting, authorizing construction, reconstruction and equipping of school buildings

Regular Board of Education Meeting, Tuesday, October 23, 2018 and other facilities, various site improvements, and other incidental improvements required therefor, at a maximum estimated aggregate cost of \$43,700,000, the issuance of debt obligations of the School District therefor, and the levy of a tax in annual installments therefor, with such tax to be partially offset by state aid available therefor, all as more fully described in such notice, be approved?

The School District, acting under the State Environmental Quality Review Act and the applicable regulations promulgated thereunder ("SEQRA"), has completed its environmental review and, on October 23, 2018, has duly found the purpose to be a type II action under SEQRA which will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts.
