AGE. STATED INTEGRATED ARTS, ETC IS GOOD - CREATES A WELL-ROUNDED  
STUDENT. LUANN PHILLIPS OF 40 CHAPMAN AVE., IS A FORMER STUDENT OF  
GENESEE WHO FEELS THE NEW 6 DAY ROTATION WILL BE DETRIMENTAL TO
