Dear Herman Ave. Elementary School Community:

Safe and healthy school environments can foster healthy and successful children. To protect public health, the Public Health Law and New York State Health Department (NYSDOH) regulations require that all public schools and boards of cooperative educational services (BOCES) test lead levels in water from every outlet that is being used, or could potentially be used, for drinking and cooking. If lead is found at any water outlet at levels above 15 parts per billion (ppb), which is equal to 15 micrograms per liter, the NYSDOH requires that the school take action to reduce the exposure to lead.

I'd like to take this opportunity to inform you that we now have received all lead test data from samples of water that were taken from Herman Ave. Elementary School on 3/4/20. Of 73 samples tested, two sites in the building slightly exceeded the permissible limit (15 micrograms per liter) as defined by state law. These two sites and the district's actions taken/actions planned are described below.

- 116 Kitchen – Sink: (0.039 mg/L), sampled on 3/4/20  
Actions taken: sign posted indicating sink is for hand washing only  
Actions planned: reevaluate and repair, re-sampling
- 123A Bathroom – Sink: (0.019 mg/L), sampled on 3/4/20  
Actions taken: sign posted indicating sink is for hand washing only  
Actions planned: reevaluate and repair, re-sampling

As indicated above, in order to ensure the quality of water in the school buildings, we have displayed a sign above each sink with an elevated lead level that indicates it is for hand washing only. We will be replacing fixtures in these sinks. We will then retest the two water outlets for lead.
