Policy Update: Use of Internet-Enabled Devices During the School Day

To keep students focused on learning and to follow the new state law, the District has adopted a new policy limiting the use of **internet-enabled devices** during the school day.

What counts as an internet-enabled device?

This includes **cell phones, iWatches/smartwatches, tablets, internet-enabled glasses, and any other device capable of connecting to the internet.**

Key Points for Families:

- Students are **not permitted to use internet-enabled devices** during the school day on school grounds. This applies to both instructional and non-instructional times, such as lunch, recess, study halls, and passing time.
- Exceptions are allowed if approved by a teacher or administrator for educational purposes, for health care needs, emergencies, translation services, or if required by a student's IEP or 504 plan.
- **Storage of devices:**
 - Junior high and high school students must keep devices in their lockers.
 - Elementary students will place devices in designated classroom bins.
- Parents wishing to contact their child during the day should **call the school's main office**, and messages will be relayed.

Policy Update: Keeping Students Safe During Extreme Heat

The health, safety, and comfort of our students and staff are our top priorities. The District has a policy in place to address extreme heat in our school buildings:

When rooms reach 82°F or higher:

Staff will take steps to make classrooms more comfortable. This may include dimming lights, lowering shades, using fans, increasing airflow, turning off heat-producing electronics, and ensuring students have regular water breaks. Where available, air conditioning may also be used.

When rooms reach 88°F or higher:

Students and staff will be moved to cooler areas within the school if possible. If that is not an option, schools may dismiss early following the District's emergency closing procedures. Parents and guardians will be notified promptly.

**These policies are designed to minimize distractions, create a safer learning environment, and ensure all students are fully engaged in their school experiences.*

New Student Safety Reporting System: SpeakUp for Safety

We are excited to announce that our school district has transitioned from Anonymous Alerts to **SpeakUp for Safety**, a new student safety reporting system provided by Gaggle. This platform offers students a simple and confidential way to report concerns about school safety and the well-being of their peers—such as bullying, threats of violence, or students in crisis.

There's no app to download—just a simple way to speak up when something doesn't feel right.

Messages are monitored by trained safety professionals 24/7/365, and serious concerns are immediately shared with district staff for appropriate action.

We believe SpeakUp for Safety will strengthen our efforts to maintain a safe and supportive environment for all students.

ThoughtExchange

Our district is excited to be using **ThoughtExchange**, an online engagement tool that allows everyone in our school community - families, staff, students, and community members - to share their thoughts and help shape the future of our schools. With ThoughtExchange, you can contribute ideas, see what others are saying, and help prioritize the issues that matter most by rating the thoughts shared.

This platform ensures that every voice is heard and considered, and it gives us valuable insight into what's most important to our community. Throughout the year, you will see invitations through ParentSquare, our district website, and our district social media platforms inviting you to participate in an exchange regarding a specific topic. We encourage you to take part in upcoming exchanges and join the conversation as we work together to support student success.

For the past 22 years, Auburn Education Foundation has been diligently working, through our fundraising efforts, to provide transformative learning opportunities for our students. THE DISTRICT WELLNESS POLICY

The **Auburn Enlarged City School District** is committed to providing students with a school environment that promotes student health and wellness and reduces childhood obesity. The District Wellness Policy can be viewed on the district website. As part of the policy, the district shall:

- **ensure** that all foods and beverages available in school promote good nutrition, balance and reasonable portion sizes;
- **promote** the sale of non-food items or activities for school fundraisers;
- **recommend** non-food classroom celebrations;
- **promote** the integration of physical activity in the classroom and encourage staff, families and community to participate in and model physical activity as a valuable part of daily life;
- **integrate** nutrition education that teaches the knowledge, skills and values needed to adopt healthy eating behaviors into the curriculum;
- **promote** fruits, vegetables, whole grain products, low fat dairy products, safe and healthy food preparation methods and health-enhancing nutrition practices;
- **inform** and update the public about the content, implementation and effectiveness of this policy.

• BACK-TO-SCHOOL CHECKLIST •

For Parents Who Have Students with a Health Concern:

- ➔ Make your child's health concern known to the school and school nurse.
- ➔ Introduce yourself and your child to the school nurse.
- ➔ Bring current signed healthcare provider orders.
- ➔ Together with the school nurse and other appropriate school officials, and family, develop an individualized healthcare plan (or other educational plans, as needed, e.g., 504, IEP).
- ➔ Give permission for the school nurse to communicate with your family's healthcare provider.
- ➔ Provide parent/guardian contact information and update the school with any changes.
- ➔ Ask if non-nurses will be providing care (for example, verify who will administer medication) and how these authorized individuals will be supervised.
- ➔ Confirm the school's disaster/emergency plan. Make sure your child's medication and/or medical devices (epinephrine auto-injectors, asthma inhalers, insulin, etc.) will be readily available in an emergency.

For All Parents and Students:

- ➔ Make sure immunizations are up-to-date.
- ➔ Review hygiene tips to prevent the spread of infections.
- ➔ Establish a bedtime and wake-up time to ensure adequate and consistent sleep.
- ➔ Develop a routine for homework and after school activities.
- ➔ Eat breakfast each day at home or at school.
- ➔ Help make appropriate clothing choices (for example, wear comfortable and safe shoes).
- ➔ Keep an open line of communication with your child to ensure that he/she remains safe at school. If a concern arises (such as bullying), contact the appropriate school officials immediately.
- ➔ Get involved! Sign up for the parent organization (PTA/PTO), District Wellness Committee, District Parent Council, and mark events such as back-to-school night and parent/teacher meetings on your calendar.
- ➔ Ask about the school or district's wellness policy (for example, how does the school address nutrition, activity, stress and mental health concerns).

STUDENT HEALTH EXAMINATIONS UPDATE

All students in Kindergarten and grades 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11, as well as students wishing to participate in sports or become eligible for a working permit, and all new students to the district are mandated by New York State Education Law to have a current examination on record in the health office. The Health Staff encourages you to use your private health care provider for all required school health appraisals for better continuity of care. Should you choose to have a health appraisal done by the school physician or nurse practitioner in school, it will be scheduled at the convenience of the district.

Your child will be asked to disrobe to underclothing. While every effort is made to preserve dignity and privacy, most health offices are too small to provide the level of privacy your child may be used to in his or her private provider's office.

The physician conducts a mini-interview for history. These are age appropriate questions identified by the American Medical Association and the American Academy of Pediatrics. Next, the physical screening examination is done. The exam includes a head-to-toe screening of all major organ systems. Please do not ask the school to conduct this exam unless you seek your own child's permission and understanding of the nature of the exam. Because school examinations, by law, are only screening exams and school providers may not diagnose or prescribe in a school setting, you will be advised of any areas of concern found on examination that require further evaluation by your own provider.

One last suggestion regarding private examinations. Most physicians recommend that you time annual exams around your child's birthday. It may take six to twelve weeks to schedule an appointment, especially over the summer. Please plan accordingly if you have these exams done privately. We understand that during this transition we will all need to be flexible, especially regarding sports participation. Our goal is to facilitate your child's ability to play in a chosen sport. All we ask is that if you have already had an exam done, that you please take a moment to call your private physician to get proof of the exam into the school nurse as soon as possible.

Please feel free to contact the school nurse at your child's building.

VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS APPLICABLE TO ALL STUDENTS

Public Health Law §2164 applies to children attending all schools as defined in Public Health Law §2164 which include any public, private or parochial child-caring center, day nursery, day care agency, nursery school, kindergarten, elementary, intermediate, or secondary school. Public Health Law §2164 prohibits a school from permitting any child to be admitted to such school, or to attend such school in excess of 14 days without sufficient evidence that the child has received all age-appropriate required vaccinations.

PESTICIDE NOTIFICATION

Dear Parents, Guardians, and School Staff:

New York State Education Law Section 409-H, effective July 1, 2001, requires all public and nonpublic elementary and secondary schools to provide written notification to all persons in parental relation, faculty, and staff regarding the potential use of pesticides periodically throughout the school year.

The Auburn Enlarged City School District is required to maintain a list of persons in parental relation, faculty, and staff who wish to receive 48-hour prior written notification of certain pesticide applications. The following pesticide applications are not subject to prior notification requirements:

- a school remains unoccupied for a continuous 72-hours following an application;
- anti-microbial products;
- nonvolatile rodenticides in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children;
- nonvolatile insecticidal baits in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children;
- silica gels and other nonvolatile ready-to-use pastes, foams, or gels in areas inaccessible to children;
- boric acid and disodium octaborate tetrahydrate;
- the application of EPA designated biopesticides;
- the application of EPA designated exempt materials under 40CFR152.25;
- the use of aerosol products with a directed spray in containers of 18 fluid ounces or less when used to protect individuals from an imminent threat from stinging and biting insects including venomous spiders, bees, wasps, and hornets.

In the event of an emergency application necessary to protect against an imminent threat to human health, a good faith effort will be made to supply written notification to those on the 48-hour prior notification list.

FEDERAL ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT (AHERA) NOTIFICATION

The Auburn Enlarged City School District, in accordance with Section 763.93 of the Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), submitted Asbestos Management Plans to the New York State Education Department in 1989. Updated and reviewed annually, these plans contain reports of the accredited asbestos inspector and the reports of the accredited laboratory which analyzed the inspection samples that were taken.

The Management Plans also describe:

- Places in each school building where asbestos was identified
- Response actions taken to date including abatement of asbestos in elementary, junior high and high school boiler rooms, corridors, classrooms, crawl spaces, and storage areas.

Copies of the Management Plans are available in each of the Principal's office and in the District office. The plans may be reviewed during regular business hours daily, Monday - Friday. Any questions or requests for additional information pertaining to the asbestos plan should be directed to:

Enhanced STAR Exemption for Senior Citizens

Senior property owners who already have a Basic STAR Exemption on their primary residence may be eligible for the Enhanced STAR Exemption when they are 65. You should apply when you are 64 so that, if you qualify, you may receive the exemption beginning the year that you turn 65. Auburn city residents should contact the Assessor's Office at City Hall on South Street (255-4125). Other Auburn (Aurelius, Throop, Owasco, Sennett, Fleming) and Cayuga County residents should contact their local assessor's office. The deadline for applications for Auburn city residents is February 1. Other Auburn and Cayuga County residents should check with their local assessor.

The Enhanced STAR program for senior citizens provides eligible seniors an exemption from school property taxes for owner-occupied, primary residences. To be eligible for this exemption, a property owner must be 65 years of age or older on December 31, 2025, with income not exceeding \$107,300.

Enhanced STAR provides qualifying households with up to a \$86,100 exemption on the full value of their property. Qualifying residents owning a home with a full value of \$100,000 would recognize an estimated tax savings of \$1,181 from the Enhanced STAR for the tax year in which they qualify.
