Dear Auburn Families,

I hope everyone had a fun and relaxing summer! We are excited to welcome everyone back for the 2022-2023 school year. We have many new faces this year, and we are looking forward to introducing new staff to students and families on the first day of school.

The summer months are a busy time as we are planning and preparing for another school year. This summer, we hosted over 90 professional learning sessions for our staff that addressed literacy, math, technology, culturally responsive practices, social-emotional learning, and secondary level curriculum work.

For the upcoming school year, we are working on a plan to expand our supports for students through multi-tiered systems where students' academic behaviors and social-emotional needs are met. Last year, we were fortunate to be able to hire social workers and counselors for each of our schools, and they will be able to continue working with students this year. This year, the district has partnered with Paper, which will provide 24/7, 1-on-1 tutoring support for all students at the high school through a secure, chat-based platform. Furthermore, the district's 1:1 technology initiative is complete; all students in K-12 will be assigned a device for the school year.

We are very excited to reopen our Innovation Labs in our elementary schools this year. Innovation Labs integrate STEAM (science, technology, research, engineering, art and math) instruction into our core curriculum. In these labs, technology instruction enhances the art and math curriculum through interdisciplinary design projects and experiments that connect to students' work in the classroom. We are looking forward to incorporating the Innovation Labs into family events through the school year as well.

Safety continues to be a priority in our district. Thanks to the completed capital project work at four of our elementary schools last school year, we now have secured vestibules in six of our schools. We have met with the Auburn Police Department multiple times to work on our safety plans throughout the district, and we have conducted safety trainings with our administrators and staff.

Please join us at our District Parent Council meetings, which are typically held the first Monday of every month at 6:30 p.m. at the Harriet Tubman Administration Building. We encourage anyone who would like to be a part of district discussions to attend. There is no need to sign up or contact anyone about joining. Just show up! Due to Labor Day, the first meeting is Monday, September 12 at 6:30 p.m.

On behalf of the Board of Education and administration, thank you for your continued support of the Auburn Enlarged City School District. We look forward to seeing all of our students on Tuesday, September 6!

The school district is pleased to continue our partnership with Anonymous Alerts®, the anti-bullying and safety reporting app and system. This safety communications tool is a way for our students to quickly communicate anonymously with school officials and engage in anonymous 2-way communications to share more information about incidents. Types of concerns that may be reported include, but are not limited to, bullying, harassment, drug-related issues, fighting, weapons, threats, and more. The goal of this reporting system is to help maintain a safe school climate while giving students ample opportunity to securely communicate with school administrators without fear of retribution by their peers. The system will be monitored during school days between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.

AECSD Summer Programming

This summer the Auburn Enlarged City School District hosted summer school programming opportunities for over 500 students in grades kindergarten through 12. The instruction for students in grades kindergarten-8th grade focused on skills development in literacy and mathematics; and students in grades 9-12 were enrolled in credit recovery classes or structured work groups where they worked through the online program Edgenuity through a partnership with Cayuga-Onondaga BOCES. Our elementary program site also provided summer programming for our students with disabilities that qualify for extended school year programming. Both our elementary and secondary level sites experienced great success and the students prospered as they were provided the time to reinforce and grow their skills and close learning gaps.



Engaging in Professional Learning



This summer the Auburn Enlarged City School District hosted over 90 professional learning sessions for over 340 teachers, teaching assistants, teacher aides and school support staff. The sessions offered included a focus on literacy, mathematics, culturally responsive teaching and practices, department curricular work, and innovative projects slated to be implemented this year. Our sessions were facilitated by our instructional coaches, department teacher leaders, district administrators, and in collaboration with BOCES staff and outside partners.

We are very excited to be able to offer so many opportunities for continued growth for our staff and look forward to the 2022-23 school year!

Updates on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion Strategies

- The DEI Task Force is expanding its membership for the 2022-23 school year to include additional staff and community members.
- Dr. Reneé Burgess, Executive Director of DEI and Instruction along with Bill Berry, DEI consultant, completed the second “Meet and Greet,” an opportunity for parents and community members to become informed about the district’s DEI plans while offering their comments and suggestions. Convened at the Tubman administration building, Superintendent, Jeff Pirozzolo, Amy Mahunik, Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum and Instruction, and School Board President, Ian Phillips attended this session and also responded to participant concerns.
- The final “Meet and Greet” for the summer series will be held at the Booker T. Washington Community Center at 23 Chapman Avenue on Saturday, September 17 from 12-1 pm. Lunch will be served and interested participants must register by sending an email to reneeburgess@aecsd.education and state any dietary restrictions.
- Reneé and Bill participated in the Auburn Police Department’s “National Night Out, a nationwide event to enhance the relationships between local law enforcement and the community. With many police officers available to meet and talk to residents, this festive and informational affair was held on the grounds of the Equal Rights Heritage Center with live music, food trucks, tables representing community service organizations, and children-related activities.
- The United Way of Cayuga County Executive Director, Kathryn Dennis, and Reneé presented a proposal to the district’s cabinet members to develop a “Student United” at the high school. Student United will build leadership to initiate the first group of its kind at the high school.
- On August 4, district personnel, including all cabinet members and the entire administrative team, participated in the United Way’s “Day of Caring,” an annual program to assist the work of local non-profits in a variety of work tasks. The AECSD team volunteered at the SCAT Van and the Salvation Army, performing various tasks. Bill Berry, a UWCC board member, performed a clean-up after the cook-out and ceremony for the day’s volunteers, held at the Throop Firehouse.
- Reneé will be a member of the Leadership Cayuga 2023 class and is joining the board at Cayuga Counseling.
- The district’s inaugural summer book club completed its initial reading and discussions in August. Over twenty administrators and teachers participated in reading Sheree Atcheson’s *Demanding More, Why diversity and inclusion don’t happen and what you can do about it.*



STUDENT HEALTH EXAMINATIONS UPDATE

All students in Kindergarten and grades 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11, as well as students wishing to participate in sports or become eligible for a working permit, and all new students to the district are mandated by New York State Education Law to have a current examination on record in the health office. The Health Staff encourages you to use your private health care provider for all required school health appraisals for better continuity of care. Should you choose to have a health appraisal done by the school physician or nurse practitioner in school, it will be scheduled at the convenience of the district.

Your child will be asked to disrobe to underclothing. While every effort is made to preserve dignity and privacy, most health offices are too small to provide the level of privacy your child may be used to in his or her private provider's office.

The physician conducts a mini-interview for history. These are age appropriate questions identified by the American Medical Association and the American Academy of Pediatrics. Next, the physical screening examination is done. The exam includes a head-to-toe screening of all major organ systems. Please do not ask the school to conduct this exam unless you seek your own child's permission and understanding of the nature of the exam. Because school examinations, by law, are only screening exams and school providers may not diagnose or prescribe in a school setting, you will be advised of any areas of concern found on examination that require further evaluation by your own provider.

One last suggestion regarding private examinations. Most physicians recommend that you time annual exams around your child's birthday. It may take six to twelve weeks to schedule an appointment, especially over the summer. Please plan accordingly if you have these exams done privately. We understand that during this transition we will all need to be flexible, especially regarding sports participation. Our goal is to facilitate your child's ability to play in a chosen sport. All we ask is that if you have already had an exam done, that you please take a moment to call your private physician to get proof of the exam into the school nurse as soon as possible.

IMMUNIZATIONS NOTICE:

At this time, the NYSDOH is not issuing exceptions for immunizations because of COVID-19.

The Department's stance continues to be that students missing vaccine doses for any reason must comply with Public Health Law Section 2164 requirements. Children entering or attending school in New York State, including summer school and distance learning, must comply with said requirements.

THE DISTRICT WELLNESS POLICY

The **Auburn Enlarged City School District** is committed to providing students with a school environment that promotes student health and wellness and reduces childhood obesity. The District Wellness Policy can be viewed on the district website. As part of the policy, the district shall:

- **ensure** that all foods and beverages available in school promote good nutrition, balance and reasonable portion sizes;
- **promote** the sale of non-food items or activities for school fundraisers;
- **require** non-food classroom celebrations;
- **promote** the integration of physical activity in the classroom and encourage staff, families and community to participate in and model physical activity as a valuable part of daily life;
- **integrate** nutrition education that teaches the knowledge, skills and values needed to adopt healthy eating behaviors into the curriculum;
- **promote** fruits, vegetables, whole grain products, low fat dairy products, safe and healthy food preparation methods and health-enhancing nutrition practices;
- **inform** and update the public about the content, implementation and effectiveness of this policy.

• BACK-TO-SCHOOL CHECKLIST •

For Parents Who Have Students with a Health Concern:

- ➔ Make your child's health concern known to the school and school nurse.
- ➔ Introduce yourself and your child to the school nurse.
- ➔ Bring current signed healthcare provider orders.
- ➔ Together with the school nurse and other appropriate school officials, and family, develop an individualized healthcare plan (or other educational plans, as needed, e.g., 504, IEP).
- ➔ Give permission for the school nurse to communicate with your family's healthcare provider.
- ➔ Provide parent/guardian contact information and update the school with any changes.
- ➔ Ask if non-nurses will be providing care (for example, verify who will administer medication) and how these authorized individuals will be supervised.
- ➔ Confirm the school's disaster/emergency plan. Make sure your child's medication and/or medical devices (epinephrine auto-injectors, asthma inhalers, insulin, etc.) will be readily available in an emergency.

For All Parents and Students:

- ➔ Make sure immunizations are up-to-date.
- ➔ Review hygiene tips to prevent the spread of infections.
- ➔ Establish a bedtime and wake-up time to ensure adequate and consistent sleep.
- ➔ Develop a routine for homework and after school activities.
- ➔ Eat breakfast each day at home or at school.
- ➔ Help make appropriate clothing choices (for example, wear comfortable and safe shoes).
- ➔ Keep an open line of communication with your child to ensure that he/she remains safe at school. If a concern arises (such as bullying), contact the appropriate school officials immediately.
- ➔ Get involved! Sign up for the parent organization (PTA/PTO), District Wellness Committee, District Parent Council, and mark events such as back-to-school night and parent/teacher meetings on your calendar.
- ➔ Ask about the school or district's wellness policy (for example, how does the school address nutrition, activity, stress and mental health concerns).

Measurements are taken from a point on the public road opposite the front door of the school to a point on the public road in front of the home. No private roads may be included in the computations. The district uses a Board approved routing program: Transfinder. Requests to have transportation distances re-measured must be made before October 1st. PESTICIDE NOTIFICATION

Dear Parents, Guardians, and School Staff:

New York State Education Law Section 409-H, effective July 1, 2001, requires all public and nonpublic elementary and secondary schools to provide written notification to all persons in parental relation, faculty, and staff regarding the potential use of pesticides periodically throughout the school year.

The Auburn Enlarged City School District is required to maintain a list of persons in parental relation, faculty, and staff who wish to receive 48-hour prior written notification of certain pesticide applications. The following pesticide applications are not subject to prior notification requirements:

- a school remains unoccupied for a continuous 72-hours following an application;
- anti-microbial products;
- nonvolatile rodenticides in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children;
- nonvolatile insecticidal baits in tamper resistant bait stations in areas inaccessible to children;
- silica gels and other nonvolatile ready-to-use pastes, foams, or gels in areas inaccessible to children;
- boric acid and disodium octaborate tetrahydrate;
- the application of EPA designated biopesticides;
- the application of EPA designated exempt materials under 40CFR152.25;
- the use of aerosol products with a directed spray in containers of 18 fluid ounces or less when used to protect individuals from an imminent threat from stinging and biting insects including venomous spiders, bees, wasps, and hornets.

In the event of an emergency application necessary to protect against an imminent threat to human health, a good faith effort will be made to supply written notification to those on the 48-hour prior notification list.

FEDERAL ASBESTOS HAZARD EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT (AHERA) NOTIFICATION

The Auburn Enlarged City School District, in accordance with Section 763.93 of the Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), submitted Asbestos Management Plans to the New York State Education Department in 1989. Updated and reviewed annually, these plans contain reports of the accredited asbestos inspector and the reports of the accredited laboratory which analyzed the inspection samples that were taken.

The Management Plans also describe:

- Places in each school building where asbestos was identified
- Response actions taken to date including abatement of asbestos in elementary, junior high and high school boiler rooms, corridors, classrooms, crawl spaces, and storage areas.

Copies of the Management Plans are available in each of the Principal's office and in the District office. The plans may be reviewed during regular business hours daily, Monday - Friday. Any questions or requests for additional information pertaining to the asbestos plan should be directed to:

This now also applies to post-secondary institutions (colleges), upon request.

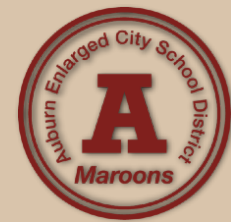
Enhanced STAR Exemption for Senior Citizens

Senior property owners who already have a Basic STAR Exemption on their primary residence may be eligible for the Enhanced STAR Exemption when they are 65. You should apply when you are 64 so that, if you qualify, you may receive the exemption beginning the year that you turn 65. Auburn city residents should contact the Assessor's Office at City Hall on South Street (255-4125). Other Auburn (Aurelius, Throop, Owasco, Sennett, Fleming) and Cayuga County residents should contact their local assessor's office. The deadline for applications for Auburn city residents is February 1. Other Auburn and Cayuga County residents should check with their local assessor.

The Enhanced STAR program for senior citizens provides eligible seniors an exemption from school property taxes for owner-occupied, primary residences. To be eligible for this exemption, a property owner must be 65 years of age or older on December 31, 2022, with income not exceeding \$92,000.

STAR provides qualifying households with up to a \$74,900 exemption on the full value of their property. Qualifying residents owning a home with a full value of \$100,000 would recognize an estimated tax savings of \$1,181 from the Enhanced STAR for the tax year in which they qualify.
