Dear Casey Park Families,

With that being said, please remember that assignments must be completed each day in order to keep up with our daily curriculum expectations.

As many of you have noticed, we have established some new arrival and dismissal procedures. Please make sure that you are following the guidelines in order to maintain the health and safety of all students and staff members. As a reminder:

- If you are dropping your child off and do not need to exit the vehicle yourself, please pull over in the approved sections on the street. Students will exit on the car on the side of the sidewalk and will either walk to the crosswalk or walk on the sidewalk to the school entry.
- If you need to come to the door with your child, YOU MUST park in the further half of the parking lot across from the school and not on the street. Please walk to the sidewalk and utilize the crosswalk when crossing the street.
- Handicapped spaces are clearly designated in the parking lot across from school. Please do not park here unless you have handicap permissions, which can be clearly viewed.
- Please do not stop and let children out in the middle of the street or in the middle of the crosswalk.
- No thru traffic in the staff parking lot on the east side of the school.
- Make sure children are not crossing through the bus lane.
 They should always cross at the crosswalk where there is a crossing guard.
